### Minimum Age for Comps

British Gymnastics have now ruled that Under 8s may not be announced as Regional or County Champions, and, since sending out the original information, we have been advised that this restriction extends to the giving of medals for 1st 2nd and 3rd places. However, on consultation with BG, some alternative awards will be presented in the under 8's categories for the Floor and Vault Championship. These are as follows:

## Under 8s Vault: Best straddle or squat on vault Best straddle or squat through vault Most dynamic vault Least deductions on vault

I'm sure that you have spotted that the WTC has a new sound system for competitions. Very nice it is too, although very heavy, tricky to transport and needs a degree to operate it.


It is available for your competitions, but you will need to provide the transport and make sure it is returned in the same condition that you took it in.


